Tickets for non-players

Great views from the stands

Although on field access is limited to players & staff, guests will be able to catch all of the action from the park's many seated & standing viewing areas. Admission is GA and guests are encouraged to move around to get the best view of each of the nine fields.

On the field

Players must have their player badges with them every time they enter the field area. In addition, the badges will allow players to access to the batting cage area to warm up and the reserved player seating area. Properly credentialed players & staff ONLY are allowed on the field.



2021 Rule Reminders

Adjustment to the 2021 Rulebook

When bases are automatically loaded in extra innings, a cleanly fielded ground ball thrown to the BACKSTOP will record an out at home (no run scores, bases still loaded). If a double play is attempted, the throw still must hit the target strike zone to keep a run from scoring.

Rule Clarification

A pitch must COMPLETELY miss the batter's box carpet to be ruled a wild pitch.

Keeping Pace

Same as last year, games should begin within **5 minutes** of the conclusion of the prior game on the same field.


To assist, target strike zones will once again be placed in both bullpen areas. The batting cage area will also be open to players to warm up in. We do not want pitchers to rush through their warm ups and risk injury, but the "heavy lifting" (throwing a baseball, warm ups for those that need more than 15-20 pre-game pitches, etc.) should be completed before taking the field.

- 3-1 teams (6) to bridge round
- 2-2 teams (12) detour to Route 2
- 1-3 & 0-3 teams (10) eliminated

ROUTE 2

24 teams (2-2 Route 1 + 12 byes) 6 pools of 4 teams

- Pool winners (6) advance to Final 16.
- Pool runners-up (6) advance to Final 22.



ROUTE 2 TIEBREAKERS

- 1. Route 2 record
- 2. Total tournament losses
- 3. Head to Head
- 4. Runs allowed

In event of 3 teams tied at 2-1, pool winner is determined first, then it goes back to the top tiebreaker to break tie between the remaining 2 teams.

BRIDGE ROUND

12 teams (3-1 Route 1 + Route 2 pool runners-up)

- Single Elimination
- Positioning is pre-slotted
- Winners to Final 16
- · Losers eliminated

FINAL 16

16 teams (Bridge winners + Route 2 pool play winners + Route 1 3-0)

- Single Elimination
- #1-#10 seeds in final 16 reseeded based on record.
